## IT'S NOT TOO LATE!

You can **register and vote** at your convenience within the 30-day period before the November 4th General Election, including the day of the election **but only at your County Election Office.**

Don't know where your elections office is?

Most, but not all, are in the County Court House.

### HOURS

The day of the election, you can register and vote from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

For 30 days before the election, you can register and vote during normal Courthouse hours, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Tip: Register/vote BEFORE election day to avoid lines!

### YOU WILL NEED TO BRING YOUR ID:

A picture I.D. (such as a drivers license, state, school or tribal I.D.) or an official document with your current address (such as your utility bill, paycheck, benefit check or bank statement)
